Peace In Your Relationships

1. Self-focused

Matthew 1:18-19 This is how Jesus the Messiah was born. His mother, Mary, was engaged to be married to Joseph. But before the marriage took place, while she was still a virgin, she became pregnant through the power of the Holy Spirit. ¹⁹ Joseph, to whom she was engaged, was a righteous man and did not want to disgrace her publicly, so he decided to break the engagement quietly. (NLT)

Philippians 2:3–5 Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, ⁴ not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others. ⁵ In your relationships with one another, have the same mindset as Christ Jesus: (NIV)

2. Emotion-driven

1. Anger

Proverbs 29:22 An angry person stirs up conflict, and a hot-tempered person commits many sins. (NIV)

Ephesians 4:26 "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, (NIV)

2. Bitterness

Hebrews 12:15 See to it that no one falls short of the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many. (NIV)

3. Pride

Proverbs 11:2 When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom. (NIV)

3. A lack of conflict resolution skills

God's Way Of Resolving Conflict:

1. Go to the person

Matthew 18:15 "If another believer sins against you, go privately and point out the offense. If the other person listens and confesses it, you have won that person back. (NLT)

2. Talk it out

1. Talk with the right tone

Proverbs 15:1 A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh word stirs up anger. (NIV)

2. Talk with your posture

3. Talk with your ears

James 1:19 Understand this, my dear brothers and sisters: You must all quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to get angry. (NLT)

4. Talk to resolve

1 Peter 3:10–11 For, "Whoever would love life and see good days must keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech. ¹¹ They must turn from evil and do good; they must seek peace and pursue it. (NIV)
