# What Do You Do When A Comeback Is Not Possible?

### 1. Remember God knows right where you are

**1 Kings 17: 9** Go at once to Zarephath in the region of Sidon and stay there. I have directed a widow there to supply you with food." (NIV)

**Psalm 46:1** God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble. (NIV)

### 2. Give Jesus your last meal

Psalm 71:1–5 In you, LORD, I have taken refuge; let me never be put to shame. <sup>2</sup> In your righteousness, rescue me and deliver me; turn your ear to me and save me. <sup>3</sup> Be my rock of refuge, to which I can always go; give the command to save me, for you are my rock and my fortress. <sup>4</sup> Deliver me, my God, from the hand of the wicked, from the grasp of those who are evil and cruel. <sup>5</sup> For you have been my hope, Sovereign LORD, my confidence since my youth. (NIV)

# 3. Keep obeying God's word

**1 Kings 17:13-15** <sup>13</sup> Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small loaf of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. <sup>14</sup> For this is what the LORD, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the LORD sends rain on the land.' " <sup>15</sup> She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. (NIV)

**Proverbs 3:5** Trust in the LORD with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; (NIV)

## 4. God will give you grace for every season

**1 Kings 17:15-16** She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. <sup>16</sup> For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the LORD spoken by Elijah. (NIV)

**2 Corinthians 12:7–9** or because of these surpassingly great revelations. Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited, I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. <sup>8</sup> Three times I pleaded with the
