1. You are born again

4 Truths About The Born Again Experience

1. You have eternal life in heaven

John 3:16-17 "For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.

¹⁷ For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through him. (NIV)

John 5:24 "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life. (NIV)

2. Your sins are forgiven

Isa 43:25 "I, even I, am he who blots out your transgressions, for my own sake, and remembers your sins no more. (NIV)

Heb 8:11-12 No longer will a man teach his neighbor, or a man his brother, saying, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know me, from the least of them to the greatest. ¹² For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." (NIV)

Ps 103:12 as far as the east is from the west, so far has he removed our transgressions from us. (NIV)

Eph 1:6-7 to the praise of his glorious grace, which he has freely given us in the One he loves. ⁷ In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with the riches of God's grace (NIV)

1 John 1:9 If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. (NIV)

3. You are righteous

2 Cor 5:21 God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God. (NIV)

Rom 3:21-22 But now a righteousness from God, apart from law, has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. ²² This

righteousness from God comes through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. (NIV)

Rom 8:10 But if Christ is in you, your body is dead because of sin, yet your spirit is alive because of righteousness. (NIV)

Rom 10:4 Christ is the end of the law so that there may be righteousness for everyone who believes. (NIV)

2 Cor 6:14 Do not be yoked together with unbelievers. For what do righteousness and wickedness have in common? Or what fellowship can light have with darkness? (NIV)

2 Peter 3:13 But in keeping with his promise we are looking forward to a new heaven and a new earth, the home of righteousness. (NIV)

4. You are a new creation

2 Cor 5:17-18 Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; the old has gone, the new has come! ¹⁸ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: (NIV)

Gal 6:15 Neither circumcision nor uncircumcision means anything; what counts is a new creation. (NIV)

John 3:1-7 Now there was a man of the Pharisees named Nicodemus, a member of the Jewish ruling council. ² He came to Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know you are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the miraculous signs you are doing if God were not with him." ³ In reply Jesus declared, "I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again." ⁴ "How can a man be born when he is old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely he cannot enter a second time into his mother's womb to be born!" ⁵ Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. ⁶ Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. ⁷ You should not be surprised at my saying, 'You must be born again.' (NIV)

1 Peter 1:23 For you have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God. (NIV)

2. You are a child of God

1 John 3:1-2 How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God! And that is what we are! The reason the world does not know us is that it did not know him. ² Dear friends, now we are children of

God, and what we will be has not yet been made known. But we know that when he appears, we shall be like him, for we shall see him as he is. (NIV)

1 Peter 3:12 For the eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their prayer, but the face of the Lord is against those who do evil.” (NIV)

Heb 1:14 Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation? (NIV)

Rom 12:17-19 Do not repay anyone evil for evil. Be careful to do what is right in the eyes of everybody. ¹⁸ If it is possible, as far as it depends on you, live at peace with everyone. ¹⁹ Do not take revenge, my friends, but leave room for God’s wrath, for it is written: “It is mine to avenge; I will repay,” says the Lord. (NIV)

Rom 8:14 because those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. (NIV)

Ps 37:23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way. (NKJV)

Phil 4:19 And my God shall supply all your need according to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus. (NKJV)

Rom 8:28 And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose. (NIV)

Gal 5:16 So I say, live by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the sinful nature. (NIV)

James 4:7 Submit yourselves, then, to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. (NIV)

Phil 4:6-7 Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and petition, with thanksgiving, present your requests to God. ⁷ And the peace of God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus. (NIV)

Rom 14:17 For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking, but of righteousness, peace and joy in the Holy Spirit, (NIV)

3. You are more than a conqueror

Rom 8:37 No, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him who loved us. (NIV)
