1. The Wall

2. The Way

Joshua 6:3-5 You and your fighting men should march around the town once a day for six days. ⁴ Seven priests will walk ahead of the Ark, each carrying a ram's horn. On the seventh day you are to march around the town seven times, with the priests blowing the horns. ⁵ When you hear the priests give one long blast on the rams' horns, have all the people shout as loud as they can. Then the walls of the town will collapse, and the people can charge straight into the town." (NLT)

Four characteristics of The Way

1. The Way is specific
2. The Way won't always make sense
3. The Way takes commitment
4. The Way takes faith

Hebrews 11:30 It was by faith that the people of Israel marched around Jericho for seven days, and the walls came crashing down. (NLT)

Joshua 6:2 But the LORD said to Joshua, "I have given you Jericho, its king, and all its strong warriors." (NLT)

3. The Worship

Joshua 6:6-9 So Joshua called together the priests and said, "Take up the Ark of the LORD's Covenant, and assign seven priests to walk in front of it, each carrying a ram's horn." ⁷ Then he gave orders to the people: "March around the town, and the armed men will lead the way in front of the Ark of the LORD." ⁸ After Joshua spoke to the people, the seven priests with the rams' horns started marching in the presence of the LORD, blowing the horns as they marched. And the Ark of the LORD's Covenant followed behind them. ⁹ Some of the armed men marched in front of the priests with the horns and some behind the Ark, with the priests continually blowing the horns. (NLT)

Joshua 6:5 When you hear the priests give one long blast on the rams' horns, have all the people shout as loud as they can. Then the walls of the town will collapse, and the people can charge straight into the town." (NLT)

Joshua 6:16 The seventh time around, as the priests sounded the long blast on their horns, Joshua commanded the people, "Shout! For the LORD has given you the town!" (NLT)

4. The Win

Joshua 6:20 When the people heard the sound of the rams' horns, they shouted as loud as they could. Suddenly, the walls of Jericho collapsed, and the Israelites charged straight into the town and captured it. (NLT)
